






# What is ThinkBIG?

- An organization created in 2014 to help local pediatric cancer patients and their families with the financial burdens associated with their cancer diagnosis
- Many families spend a significant amount of time in the hospital or traveling to and from appointments
  - Because of this, it's not uncommon for a parent/caregiver to take a leave of absence from work
  - This loss of income quickly adds financial burdens to the family, and this is what ThinkBIG is trying to alleviate
- Since being founded, ThinkBIG has allocated more than \$780,000 worth of financial support to more than 140 different families
  - Helps families pay for rent, oil bills, electric bills, and items associated to their medical condition
  - Also unfortunately covers funeral expenses
  - Send all families a \$250 Weis Markets gift card to help with groceries during the holiday season

# What is High Schools For Hope?

- An online fundraising competition between school districts throughout central and northeast Pennsylvania in which proceeds benefit ThinkBIG
- 10% of each schools fundraising total will be donated back to the school to use for extra-curricular activity funds
- The top fundraising school will have 20% of their funds donated back, and the second place fundraising school will have 15% donated back
- Top fundraising students (male and female) will win a \$250 gift card
- Opportunities to win other prizes/gift cards
- Fundraising competition will conclude with a live streamed social media production that will feature DJ DOSK and testimonials from ThinkBIG families

#### ThinkBIG High Schools for Hope Website

#### Timeline

- Sunday March 28th: Fundraising for High Schools for Hope kicks off
- Friday April 16th: Donations raised offline are due to ThinkBIG in order to be eligible for High Schools for Hope competition
- Sunday April 25th: Social media production featuring DJ DOSK. Fundraising concludes at 9 PM. Event tentatively scheduled to be hosted at Berwick Teen Center
- Sunday May 2nd: Winners/prizes announced via Instagram



#### PRIZES

- All participating schools will receive 10% of their fundraised total donated back to their school
  - 1st Place School: 20% Donated Back
  - 2nd Place School: 15% Donated Back
- Top Male Fundraiser (All Districts): \$250 Gift Card
- Top Female Fundraiser (All Districts): \$250 Gift Card

# **Challenge Prizes**

- **Patriotic Prize:** The school district that collects a donation from the most unique states will win \$200 towards their school district's overall fundraised total. The donation must be a minimum of \$10 to be eligible, and will be based on the credit card payment address
- **Miles Away Prize:** The school district that collects a donation the furthest away from 530 Montour Blvd, Bloomsburg, PA will win \$200 toward their school district's overall fundraised total (Student who collects the winning donation will also win a \$50 gift card). Winner will be determined by entering the donation billing address into Google Maps. The donation must be a minimum of \$10 to be eligible.
- Gold Leadership Prize: Each school district that posts a picture of their principal wearing a gold-themed outfit (Gold is the nationally recognized color for pediatric cancer) on their district's Facebook page will be randomly entered into a drawing to win \$200 towards their school district's overall fundraised total. Facebook post must tag ThinkBIG Pediatric Cancer Fund to be eligible. Picture must be posted by April 18<sup>th</sup>.

# **Challenge Prizes**

- Very Generous Prize: The student who collects the largest online FlipCause donation will win a \$50 gift card.
- **Mascot Mania Prize:** Each school district that posts a video of their school mascot performing a school pride skit that incorporates gold/gold ribbons on their district's Facebook page will be randomly entered into a drawing to win \$200 towards their school district's overall fundraised total. Facebook post must tag ThinkBIG Pediatric Cancer Fund to be eligible. Videos must be posted by April 18.
- Lots of Donors Prize (Individual): The student who has the most unique \$10 (or more) donors will win a \$50 gift card. Minimum donation of \$10 is required to be considered a unique donor.
- Lots of Donors Prize (School): The school who has the most unique \$10 (or more) donors will win \$200 towards their school district's overall fundraised total.
- School Pride Participation Prize: The school district that has the most students create a FlipCause fundraising page and raise a minimum of \$25 on their individual page will win \$200 towards their school district's fundraised total.

### **Challenge Prizes**

- **Out of the Gates Prize:** The first school district who reaches a fundraising total of \$1000 on their FlipCause website will win \$100 towards their overall school district fundraised total.
- **Fast Start Prize:** The school district that collects the first donation greater than \$100 will win \$100 towards their school district's overall fundraising total.
- **Pizza Party Prize (1):** Any student who has raised more than \$50 on their FlipCause fundraising page by 7 PM on April 25th will be entered into a random drawing to win a pizza party for their homeroom/sports team/club (Individual student can pick the recipient. Pizza party capped at 40 individuals).
- Fill up the Gas Tank Prize (2): Any student who has raised more than \$50 on their FlipCause fundraising page by 7 PM on April 25th will be entered into a random drawing to win a \$50 Sheetz gift card.

#### Steps to Get Involved

1. Start following ThinkBIG on Instagram (thinkbigcancerfund) and Facebook

2. Visit <u>ThinkBIG High Schools for Hope website</u> and find your high schools unique webpage

3. When at your school's page, register to become a fundraiser by clicking on "Join Your Class Team"

4. After creating your unique fundraising page, share your personal page with friends/family to start collecting donations.

#### **Tips for Collecting Donations**

1. Call close friends/family and ask them to support your High Schools for Hope campaign

2. Share your High Schools for Hope page on social media and/or email it your closest friends/family (See next slide for sample letter)

3. Organize with your peers about what friends/relatives live in different states to try to capture that prize
